

B.A.T.S. BUS SERVICE

Buffalo Area Transit System provides safe and convenient public transportation services to the communities of Johnson County. The Longmire Foundation is proud to partner with the BATS bus system and the Buffalo Senior Center to help provide transportation for event attendees during Longmire Days 2024.

This amazing group will be offering rides to events at Buffalo High School and most events at the TA Ranch south of Buffalo. Donations (cash only) are required to ride the BATS bus, and all donations benefit the Buffalo Senior Center. The pick up location for the ride service will be Prosinski Park a block west of Main Street.
